1. Present Simple: Affirmative

I live in London.

She speaks Italian fluently.

We deserve a huge desert.

2. Adverbs of Frequency: Always, Usually, Sometimes, Often, Never

James often goes to the gym

Mike and I sometimes play videogames

They always play their favorite music loudly.

3. Verb to Have: to express possession

I have two dogs and a turtle

My doctor has a very nice car

They have the highest grades.

4. There is, there are

Negative:

There isn't a big bedroom upstairs as she said.

There aren't big trees on the road. They lied.

There isn't a huge house instead, there is a small one.

Interrogative:

Is there a yard behind the house?

Are there two windows in the living room?

Are there three cups of tea?

5. **There is, there are: with answers**

Is there much water in the war?

No, there isn't.

Are there 3 dogs in the yard?

No, there aren't. Just one.

6. **Past Simple:** something which started in the past and finished in the past.

I arrived at school late

She didn't do the homework

They were at the park yesterday.

8. **Past progressive:** For longer actions

While I was driving I saw a cat

She was listening to music when she heard a strange sound.

They were playing baseball when something hit one of the elements of the team

9. **Used to:** action or habit in the PAST that is not longer in the present.

I used to watch cartoons when i was four years old.

She used to take piano leassons

We used to live in this neighbourhood

10. **CAN and COULD:** Ability / Capability

You can go to the cinema.

Smoking can cause cancer.

Can I have a biscuit, please?

COULD

Ability / Capability

Past I could swim when I was seven.

Permission We could go to the cinema once a week.

Possibility This vase could be very valuable.

Request Could I use your phone, please?

Offer Could I be of any help?

Suggestion You could buy Mary some flowers.
